



Clothespin Grasshopper



Supplies:

- 1 - Green Clothespin
(You can paint a regular Clothespin)
- 2 - Light Green Pipecleaners
- 1/2 - Moss Green Pipecleaner
- 2 - 6-7mm Self-Adhesive Googly Eyes
- Tacky Glue or Hot Glue
(Only with Adult Supervision)

1. Cut one of your light green pipecleaners in half.
2. Bend each light green pipecleaner in half, then bend each half in half again with a small amount passing the V you made.
3. At the end of each M that you have created bend the pipecleaner outward to create a "foot."
4. Bend your moss green pipecleaner in half and wrap it around the front of your green clothespin, creating the grasshopper's antennae.
5. Bend over the end of each antenna to create an L shape.



6. Peel the backing off of one googly eye at a time and place them on the front of your clothespin.
7. Squeeze open your clothespin and place a small drop of Tacky Glue or hot glue at the front of the clothespin closest to the spring.
8. Repeat Step 7 in the open space at the front of the clothespin.
9. Carefully place one of your smaller light green pipecleaner Ms at each location that you have applied the glue.
10. While holding the points of your large light green pipecleaner, pull the middle forward to create the shape of the grasshopper's legs.
11. Place a small amount of Tacky Glue or hot glue at the back of the clothespin closest to the spring and place your large light green pipecleaner M there.
12. Set your completed Clothespin Grasshopper aside to allow the glue to dry.
